

Mr K - Shropshire

We suffered a serious flood in our cottage in Shropshire in June 2007 nearly a metre in height inside which cost the insurance company £55,000. It was caused by the nearby brook overflowing its banks.

Floodark installed a five-panel barrier 1070 mm wide by 1 m high in December 2007, in an opening in a stone wall in the garden which is part of our flood defences.

On 5 September 2008 the brook again overflowed. Despite water 800 mm deep at the barrier for 3 hours, not a drop passed through as observed at the time by two people.

It takes 4 - 5 minutes to erect and less to take down. I am 76 and my wife 65. Both of us find it easy to erect”.
